The **Residential Tree Removal Application** form should be used prior to removing any trees in the neighborhood.

Attached to this form should be: (A) Property plot plan showing the footprint for the house as well as the location of any tree(s) to be removed, and (B) photograph(s) of trees to be removed.

Once this information is compiled, two original sets should be submitted to:

- I) Lawn & Landscape Committee
- II) City of Dunwoody (address shown on form)

The purpose for providing this information to the **Lawn & Landscape Committee** is to allow the Committee to review the plan from the standpoint of visual impact on the neighborhood, keeping in mind that our development is named for its wooded beauty.

Most importantly with respect to the Lawn & Landscape Committee will be favorable consideration for tree removal applications which include provisions for installation of small replacement trees of specific types (not necessarily the same type as that for which removal is requested).

The purpose for providing this information to the **City of Dunwoody** is simply as a courtesy to help the municipality track changes in the overall tree canopy for our area. This tracking procedure is essential for Dunwoody to qualify for certain environmental management programs. The City of Dunwoody does not grant or withhold permission for tree removal at established residential locations; only for new construction sites.
